

## **First Evaluation Report on the Good Neighbours Nutritional Outreach Program (May 2003)**

### **Informal Settlement in Cleveland, Johannesburg**

This settlement is home to many people who have migrated from the rural areas of KwaZulu Natal to the urban area surrounding Johannesburg city centre. As most left their homes due to the violence in their area and the search for jobs, most are living in very difficult conditions with minimal income.

900 meals twice a week.

The amount of food cooked has been doubled and two meals are given per person per day. This allows the person to eat a meal at the lunchtime when it is served and still have sufficient for a meal the following morning.

The sick and infirm that cannot get to the clearing where the food is served are sent food parcels.

**1800 meals per week total.**

### **Denver Mission School**

540 meals twice a week to children at the school (aged 4-14 years) = **1080 meals a week**

### **Malvern Clinic**

This clinic mainly treats the high number of TB and HIV+ patients in the area. A hurdle we needed to overcome was that many of the patients could not take their medication at home as they had no food to eat to assist the medication. A soup mix is cooked at the clinic and a cup of warm soup with bread is given to the patient so that the medication can be taken immediately.

400 meals per day, 3 days per week = **1200 meals per week**

### **Othandweni**

This is a street children project in Hillbrow, Johannesburg, which provides food, clothing and temporary shelter to the youth living on the street. We supply all the maize and Soya needed by the kitchen

**800 meals per week**

### **Community Care Project**

Food parcels are distributed by a Hillbrow church group to families in need in the Hillbrow and Berea areas of Johannesburg. We supply all the maize and Soya for the food parcels.

180kg Soya; 350kg maize = the equivalent of **970 meals per week**

### **Ekuthuleni Crèche, Hillbrow**

Children are placed here in a safe environment and receive food and basic schooling while their parents look for work

54 children (at the moment) 20 days per month, 2 meals per day = **540 meals per week**

### **Roly Poly Crèche, Johannesburg Inner City**

A similar project to the Ekuthuleni Crèche with 82 children

**860 meals per week**

### **Poor and Needy**

An overnight shelter that provides food twice a day – morning and evenings.

**950 meals per week**

Soya and maize for the food parcels distributed by this project

**Equivalent to 800 meals per week**

### **Impilo**

An HIV/AIDS care centre with mobile clinic and health awareness program.

**588 meals per week**
